Entry Deadline:

Applications should be submitted by May 22nd 2022. Applications received later than this deadline will be considered subject to availability of places.

Entry Process:

Entries may be made via mail, fax, or e-mail and must be complete with the following information: Athlete's first and last name / year of birth / club / team / country / event(s) to be entered / personal best and year best performance was achieved.

Entry Fee:

A non-refundable entry fee is required for each single event. This entry fee is fixed with € 10 if received on or before May 22nd 2022. Late entries will cost € 20.

Honorary awards:

The winners will receive trophies, places 1, 2 and 3 receive medals.

Legitimate interests:
